LONDON: POPULATION AND EMPLOYMENT, 1991

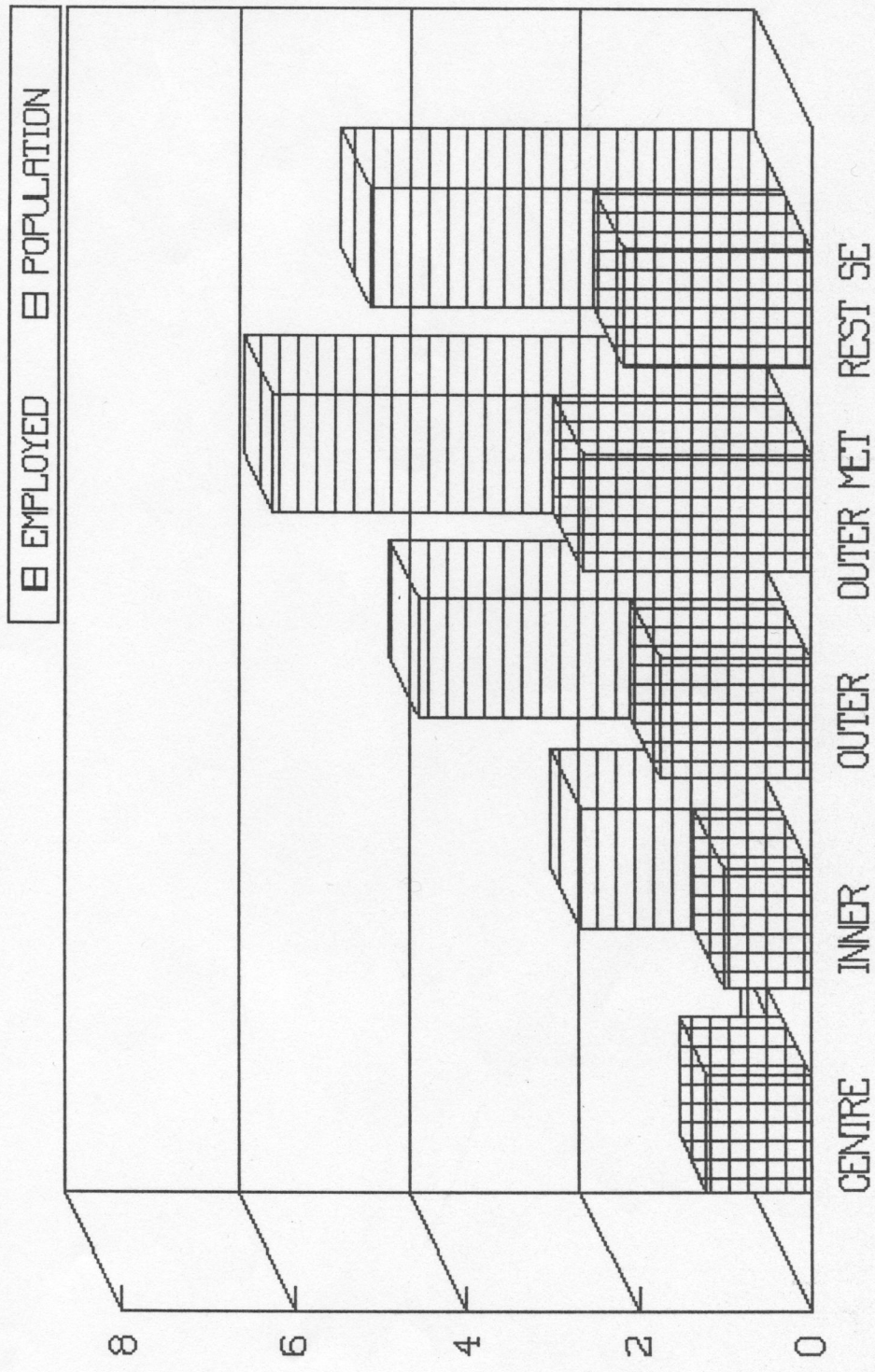
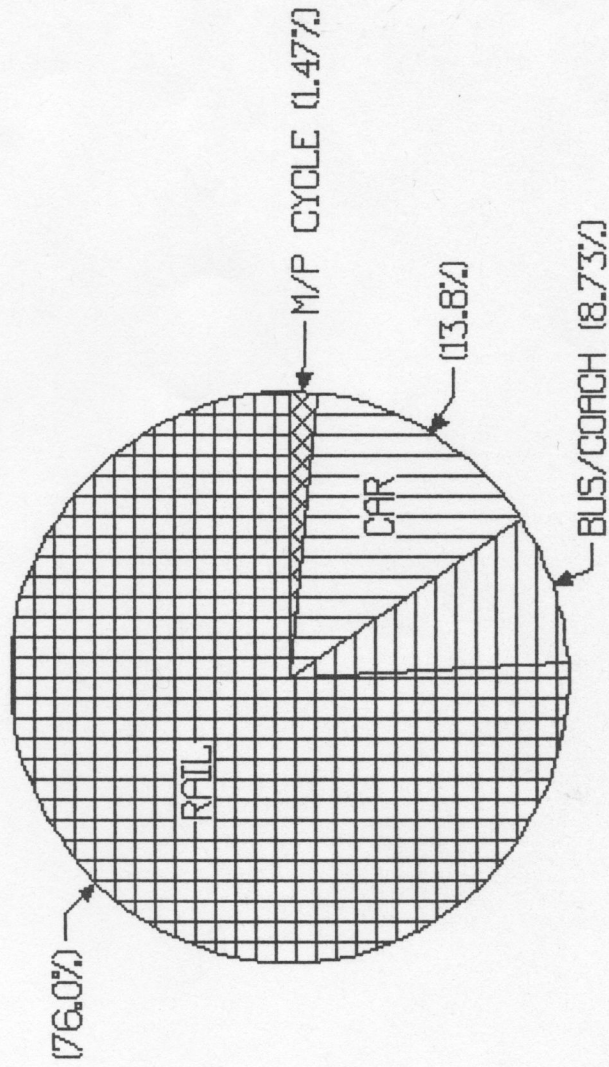

LONDON, 1983-1987 INCREASES IN DAILY RADIAL ROAD TRAFFIC (%)

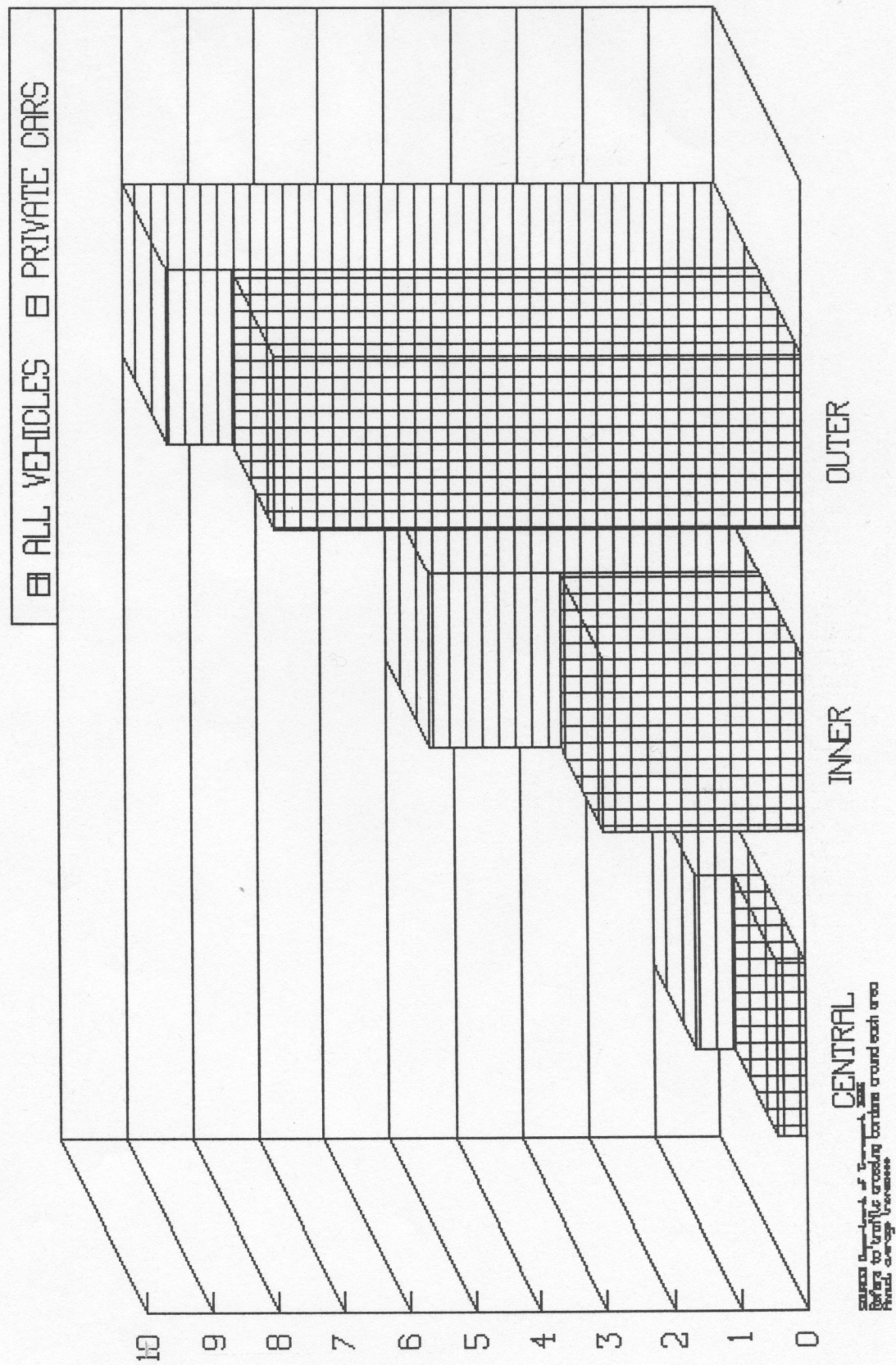
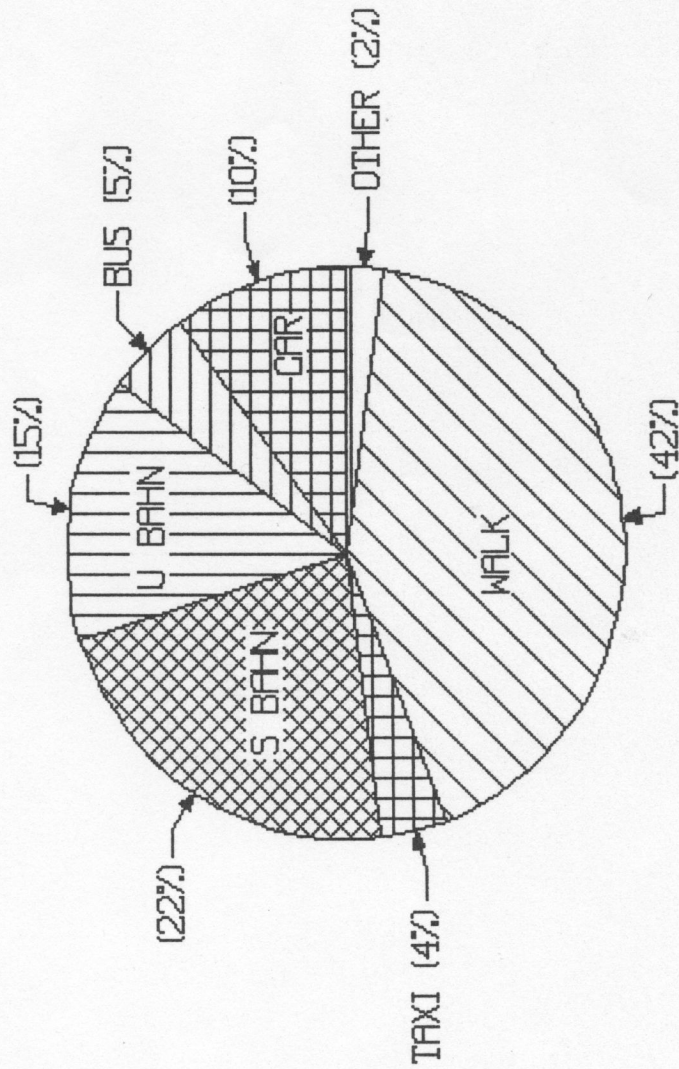

PARKING SUPPLY IN CENTRAL LONDON

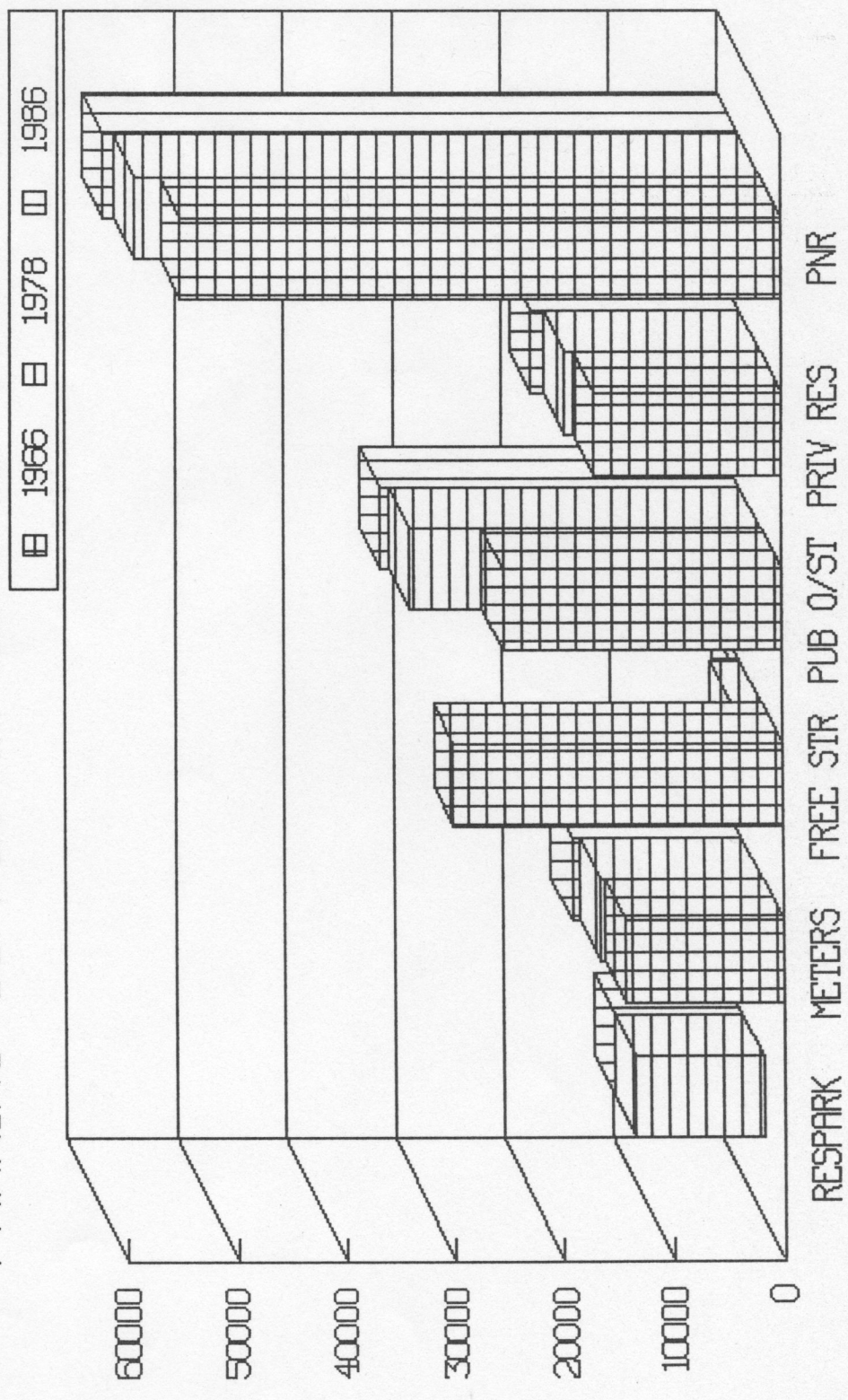

PARKING TYPES, CENTRAL LONDON 1986

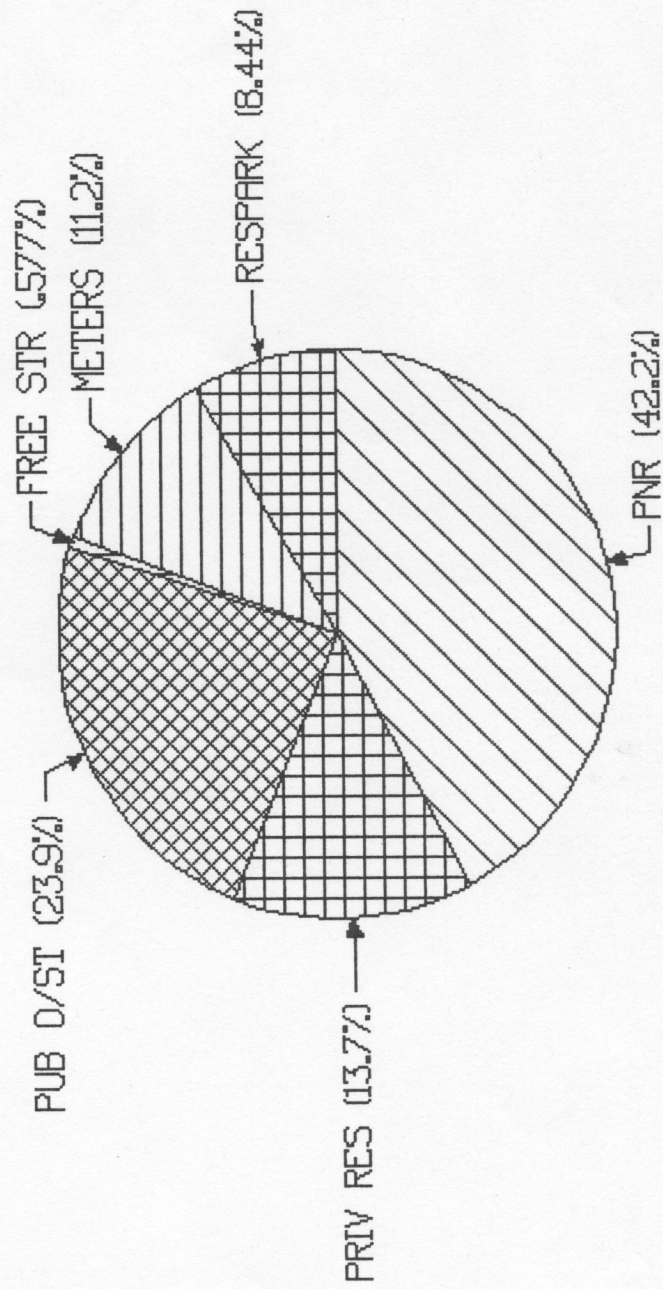
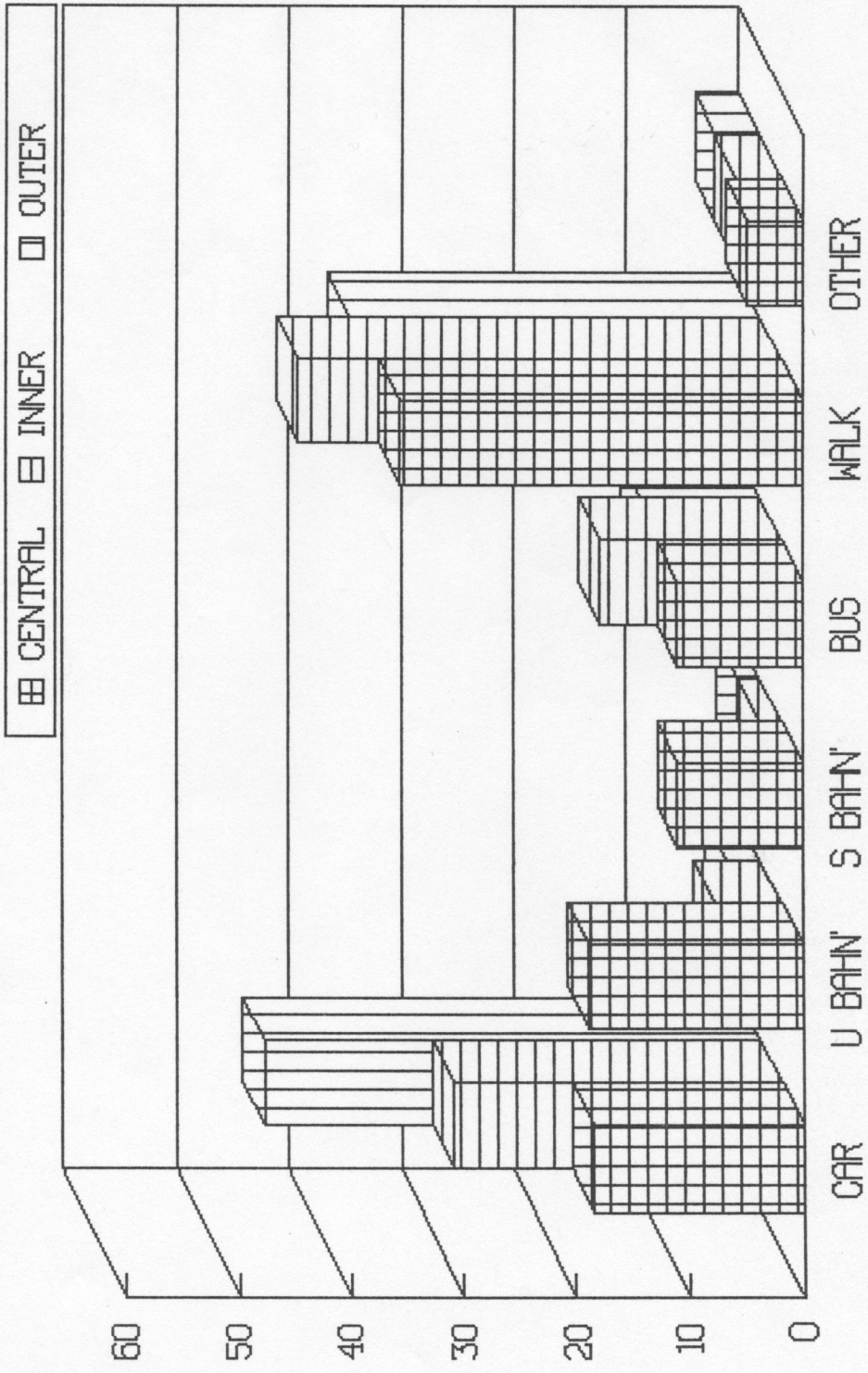
